SDTA REACHES TENTATIVE AGREEMENT

After only three days of bargaining, SDTA and the District have reached a Tentative Agreement on the second year of our 2014-2016 contract and the Legislative Council has approved it for a ratification vote by our members. Your SDTA Site Reps have copies of the official language of the Tentative Agreement. What you see here is a comprehensive summary of what is included.

Ratification elections will be held at sites Monday-Wednesday of finals week.

TENTATIVE AGREEMENT

- 5% increase to all cells in the Salary Schedule (this includes Schedules A, B, & C)
- Maintenance of fully-paid benefits with no change from 2014-15
- Conversion of ALL accrued sick leave into personal necessity leave, which may be taken without the need to request permission or give a reason.
- Agreement to convene a district-wide insurance committee to review current coverage and explore alternative coverage options (this would NOT include limiting coverage, but rather exploring the vendors and finding the best coverage for price available).
- Clean up of language regarding balancing staffing among departments, including language making it explicit that Department Chairs must be included in the conversation
- New language to ensure PE classes are not larger than 50 students and that Speech and Language Pathologist caseloads do not exceed 55 students
- Removal of the reason "To pursue an alternate career" from the reasons a member may request a leave of absence
- Removal of the specific reason "to travel" from the reasons a member may apply for a sabbatical, though clarification that travel may be a component of a project or plan of study
- Elimination of the separate due date for sabbatical requests for a personal plan of study
- Establishment of the constitution of the sabbatical committee as three reps chosen by SDTA and three chosen by the district.
