## **BARGAINING BEGINS**

The first day of negotiations between SDTA and the District took place on Wednesday, March 9<sup>th</sup>. After some good discussion around norms and expectations, the meeting consisted largely in a discussion of SDTA's proposal and clarifying questions raised by the District.

The teams will return to the table to continue this discussion on April 13<sup>th</sup>, with additional meetings scheduled for April 28<sup>th</sup>, May 11<sup>th</sup> and May 24<sup>th</sup>. While details of bargaining discussions are confidential, we will update reps and members as official proposals are made.
